This information is presented in order to assure the safety and well-being of all students at San Tan Charter School. It is also meant to ensure that all students and parents/guardians have received this communication regarding the Governing Board's special policies dealing with drug/alcohol abuse, dangerous items/lethal weapons, the attendance policy, and the Electronic Information Services (EIS) Student Acceptance Use Policy.

The signatures below indicate acknowledgement of communication regarding the following Governing Board policies found on the school's website:

- ✦ Policy regarding harassment (e.g., sexual, race, color, national origin, religion, or disability).
- ✦ Policy regarding Student Conduct.
- ✦ Policy regarding drug/alcohol abuse. We understand that drug/alcohol abuse includes illegal drugs, alcohol, prescription drugs and other mind-altering substances. Abuse includes the possession, use, distribution, sale, or purchase of any of the above.
- ✦ Policy regarding dangerous instruments and deadly weapons in school.
- ✦ Policy regarding negative student group or gang affiliation.
- ✦ Electronic Information Services Student Acceptable Use Policy.
- ✦ A student must be in attendance at least 90% OF THE TIME. Excessive absences may result in a truancy referral and/or retention, and possible placement in a Diversion Program. Excessive absences include excused and unexcused absences.
- ✦ Family Handbook that outlines other student conduct policies such as fighting, assaults, threats, bullying, inappropriate language, smoking attendance, tardiness, dress code, insubordination, etc., can be accessed on the school's website.

If the student is found in violation of these policies and agreements, he/she may be suspended or expelled from school. By signing this document, we are indicating that we are aware of these policies and that our signatures will be in force for the 2019-2020 school year.
