Directions and Observations 1. Click Take Sample Tests from link above 2. Once in the Sample Tests Sign In Portal Make sure Guest User is in the ON position 3. Then click blue SIGN IN at the bottom 4. Choose student's GRADE 5. Choose Test to practice on 6. Writing- students will write rough draft and type final draft in this portal. The use of reading material to support their writing is important to note. They will also benefit from practicing the online dictionary and thesaurus. 7. Reading- students will answer multiple questions using various types of reading passages. They may use the same passage for multiple types of questions. 8. Math- the biggest learning opportunity here is the use of the equation editor. Also, questions may ask for multiple answers.
