Directions and Observations 1. Click Take Sample Tests from left column 2. Once in the Sample Tests Page in Portal Make sure Guest User is in the ON position 3. Then click View RESULTS at the bottom 4. Choose student's GRADE 5. Choose Test to practice on 6. Writing- students will write rough draft and type final draft in this portal. The use of marking materials to support their writing is important to note. They will also benefit from practicing the online dictionary and Resources. 7. Reading- students will answer multiple questions using various types of reading passages. They may use the same passages for multiple types of questions. 8. Math- the biggest learning opportunity here is the use of the equation editor. Also, operations may ask for multiple answers.
