AP REMINDER

If your student is participating in one of our AP courses for this current school year, there is a fee of \$120 for each AP course they are enrolled in. For example, if your student is in both AP English Literature and AP World History, your total cost would be \$240.

The \$120 AP course fee covers the end of year exam that is required by The Collegeboard for all AP students; it also includes any necessary course materials.
