It was a pleasure to have so many grandparents in music this week for Grandparents Day! One of the favorite songs we sang was, "One Little Owl" (Songbook p.19 Track A16.) Along with this song your child had a chance to play our Music Together resonator bells for the first time this year!



The resonator bells are not only fun and beautiful, but they also reinforce two pitches of a song's scale that are key for young children: the dominant - the "A" bell, and the resting tone - the "D" bell. Typically, the pitch that young children sing first and most often is the dominant and resting tone (the pitches on the bells!) If you would like to buy a similar set of bells to use at home, they are only \$15 through online. A Link is included in this email.
