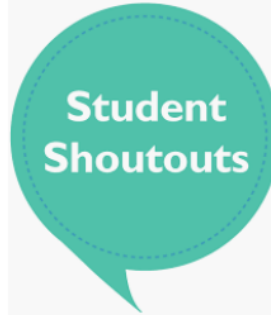
### FUTURE DREAMS
