Before this week in the Cubden classroom we worked on our solar systems. Our little bears learn to memorize the order of the planets, starting with the planet closest to the Sun and the furthest from the Sun (Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune). Sorry Pluto, we left you out.



We created our own planets by using light bulbs. We colored them to different sizes to illustrate the real differences in actual size. Finally, we painted them to match their color. We explored the wonders of our solar system right in our classroom. In the third picture you can see the planets sitting around the light up Sun bulbbase!



Next, we engaged the little bears by singing and learning to a song about the solar system to build interest in learning fascinating facts about each of the planets.
