

How to Get Information

We are providing you the following information to coordinate with your local health authority while school is closed on July 20, 2020. Please carefully read the following information regarding the school's limited bus.

School calendar: Home-based learning began on July 20th, 2020 and will continue to August 20th, 2020. Information on school's current copy of the school's calendar for the 2020-21 school year.
