

School Health Screenings

San Tan's Plan

- Staff members will be temperature checked daily upon arrival.
- A staff member will take students temperature daily upon arrival.
- Any student with visible symptoms of runny nose, cough, shortness of breath or vomiting will be taken to the health office, where parents may be contacted for pick up, with the following exceptions:
 - If the student has a runny nose and no other observable symptoms, the nurse/health aide will contact a parent to determine if other symptoms are present or if there is exposure to COVID-19 in the home. If not, the student will return to class.
 - If the student has health information that confirms a diagnosis of asthma or other respiratory condition, the nurse/health aide will contact a parent to confirm that the student has no other symptoms or exposure to COVID-19 at home. If not, the student will return to class.

Shared Belonging

San Tan's Plan

- For younger grades and where possible, student belongings to be kept in individual bins or cubbies labeled with each student's name.
- When feasible, sharing of school supplies among students to be restricted.

Volunteers/Visitors

San Tan's Plan

- Limited visitors will be permitted on school campuses. Volunteers on campus will be postponed until after October break.

Face Coverings

San Tan's Plan

Kindergarten through Sixth Grade

- **Drop Off** – Masks required unless under 6 years of age.
 - Hallways** – Masks required unless under 6 years of age.
 - Classroom** – Masks required. May be taken off for short periods while at desk or nose exposed as needed for air or other reasons.
 - Lunch** – No mask requirement while seated and eating. Mask required when walking to the lunchroom, within the lunchroom, and to the playground.
 - Playground** – Hand washing or sanitizer before and after playground. No mask requirement. Playground equipment may be used.
 - Pick Up** – Masks required unless under 6 years of age.
- **Middle School through High School**
 - Drop Off** – Masks required.
 - Hallways** – Masks required.

Classroom – Masks required. May be taken off for short periods while at desk or nose exposed as needed for air or other reasons.

Lunch – No mask requirement while seated and eating. Mask required when walking to the lunchroom and within the lunchroom. Available social distancing will be implemented.

Pick Up – Masks required.

- **Teachers and Staff**

Drop Off – Masks required.

Hallways – Masks required.

Classroom – Mask or Face Shield required.

Public Relations – Mask or Face Shield required.

Pick Up – Masks required.

Food Services

San Tan's Plan

- Students will continue to have the option to buy hot lunch or they may bring meals from home.
- Students will eat in their classrooms, cafeteria or patio, physically distanced, depending on the weather.
- All water fountain bubblers will be turned off and bottle fillers will be installed and operational.

Events/Field Trips

San Tan's Plan

- Field trips will be canceled for the first semester, until January.
- Other extracurricular activities such as clubs and sports will not be canceled.
- Teachers will use virtual learning opportunities (such as virtual tours of museums) to enhance students' educational experiences.
- Large-scale school events such as "OPEN HOUSE" will be reconfigured in order to maintain social distancing. Small-scale activities like parent-teacher conferences may take place over the phone or other electronic means.

Hand Washing

San Tan's Plan

- Staff have been trained in handwashing prior to the start of school. Staff is required to follow the handwashing policies.
- Students are trained within the first three days of school. The training includes videos, staff training students, posters hung throughout the school and verbal reminders. Hand washing includes soap/water method and hand sanitizer.
- Parents need to train their students at home on washing hands following the CDC guidelines. The CDC guidelines have been posted on website for reference.

- If students bring their own hand sanitizer, students may not share with any other person and parent understands if the sanitizer does not meet CDC guidelines, San Tan is free from liability.
- Teach and reinforce handwashing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, and increase monitoring to ensure adherence among students and staff. Posters are located in communal spaces, staff and students are trained.
- If soap and water are not readily available, hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol can be used (for staff and older children who can safely use hand sanitizer).
- Encourage staff and students to cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue. Used tissues should be thrown in the trash, and hands washed immediately with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.

Water Systems

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- Water fountains will not be in use for the start of the school year.
- Students are encouraged to bring up to two water bottles per day.
- If needed, students will be able to use the sinks to fill their water.

Intensify Cleaning and Disinfecting

San Tan's Plan

- Contracts with a certified cleaning provider (or staff) who are trained in COVID-19 procedures.
- Daily cleaning regiment with approved supplies.
- Classrooms cleaned daily, bathrooms frequently throughout the day.
- Facilities are cleaned and sanitized daily.
- Student desks and chairs are cleaned daily.

Reported Cases

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- School will maintain confidentiality, letters and notifications will refer to any student or staff as a "member of the school."
- Will notify parents with a specific letter if a member within their child's class has tested positive. Will notify all stakeholders if a member of the school has tested positive but will not give specific grade or class information.

Social Physical Distancing

San Tan's Plan

- Students will remain in their classrooms as much as they can throughout the day to limit mixing between groups as much as possible.
- Social distancing protocols will be used outside of the classroom along with limited use of common areas when feasible.

- If an emergency arises that requires a staff member to touch a student or another staff member, resume social distancing as soon as safely possible, wash hands, and disinfect any surfaces touched.
